Developed in association with WGBH, this prime time broadcast was designed to make an important contribution to the public debate over controversial art, censorship and the role of art in society.

Series Producer, *SAY BROTHER* – WGBH-TV Boston 1993-1997

Responsible for the production and management of *Say Brother*, one of the longest running continuous local series on public television. Wrote research, narration and script treatments and directed field production units. Responsibilities also included the supervision of off-line and on-line edit sessions.
